Jai-VA's website may gather information about your general Internet use by using cookies in order to help you personalise your online experience. Where used, these cookies are downloaded to your computer automatically. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

'Essential' cookies are automatically placed on your computer or device when you access our website or take certain actions on our website. 'Non-essential' cookies and other technologies are only placed on your computer or device if you have consented to us doing so. Non-essential cookies and other similar technologies will only be placed on your computer or device if you have given us your explicit consent. You can withdraw your consent or adjust your preferences at any time by revisiting the Privacy Settings fingerprint icon in the bottom left of the website (powered by Usercentrics).

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

Cookies do not typically contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal information that we store about you may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- (a) **analysis** - we use cookies to help us to analyse the use and performance of our website and services (Wix Analytics and Google Analytics (GA4) cookies) and;
- (b) **cookie consent** - we use cookies to store your preferences in relation to the use of cookies more generally (via Usercentrics).

Some of our service providers also use cookies, and those cookies may be stored on your computer when you visit our website. These are the third-party service providers that store cookies when you visit our website:

- (a) We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of our website. Google Analytics gathers information about website use by means of cookies.
